

All Patio's Refinishing Process

1.

Frame is sand blasted down removing existing finish to bare metal frame. This prepares it for your new finish.

2.

Frame is inspected for cracks and breaks. We weld and repair so the frame is smooth and like new. An additional charge may apply. We also make sure the base is level and straight. If frame is steel or iron, we apply a zinc-based primer to help prevent rust.

3.

Powder coat finish is applied. This finish is extremely durable, as it is electrostatically applied and baked on.

4.

- Strapped furniture - your new vinyl straps are added.
● New straps are designed to resist fading and mildew.
- Sling furniture - new fabric is cut, sewn and installed.

5.

Your furniture is thoroughly inspected. New glides added to insure your new frame is protected, that it will protect the surface where your furniture will sit, and to provide even wear.
